1. Opening times for the Yacht Club Building & Marina Muse Restaurant

*Patrons not resident nearby should allow sufficient travel time to return to their residence or hotel prior to the start of the National Sterilisation Programme.

2. All patrons and staff to wear facemasks when not dining in the restaurant.
3. All visitors are temperature checked. Entry permitted on temperature below 37.5 Celsius.
4. All patron visiting the restaurant must sign a policy disclaimer.
5. Visitors over 60 years of age are not permitted in the restaurant.
6. Two meters separation between patrons not seated at the same table.
7. Maximum four patrons per table.
8. Movement of tables is prohibited.
9. Maximum of two patrons in each (gents/ladies) bathroom at the same time.
10. Bathroom cubicles to be sanitised after each use.
11. Each table and chair are to be sanitised between tabs.
12. Card payment is preferred.
13. Sanitation materials are provided at every point of contact or consumption. Please use these regularly and before and after every exchange.
14. The Yacht Club will endeavour to maximise your enjoyment of the facilities while ensuring the safety of the community. Management reserve the right to refuse entry or require a patron failing to adhere to safety measures to vacate the premises.
15. Visitors from other Emirates are very welcome. Please allow sufficient commuting time to return to your residence or hotel before the commencement of national sterilisation.
